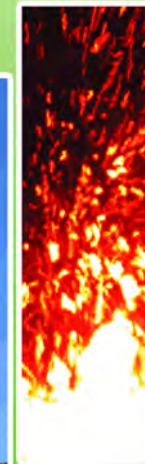

ETHIOPIA

Ethiopia is located in North East Africa shares borders with neighboring Somalia, Sudan, Eritrea, Kenya and Djibouti. It covers an area of 1,104,300km² making it the 10th largest country in Africa.

ETHIOPIA is unique and a trip to Ethiopia is a real sense of discovery.

Historically: it has the longest archeological record of any country on Earth evidenced by the discovery of the skeletal remains of Lucy and other hominids.

Religiously: is a land of the fabled queen of Sheba, home of the Ark of the Covenant and is one of the first countries adopting Christianity.

Culturally: its centuries long isolation & its unique political independence has ensured that its culture remained remarkably intact.

Naturally: it is a land of contrasts & surprises of remote & wild places. It is the birth place of coffee.

Axum: known for its mysterious obelisks and the final resting place of the Ark of the Covenant.

Lalibela: known for its rock hewn churches also called as the 8th wonders of the world.

Gondar: the Camelot of Africa famous for its castle like palaces, finely decorated churches.



Bahir Dar and Lake Tana medieval monasteries housing ecclesiastical collections & many other artifacts.

Harar: known for its old walled town and hyena men.

Tigray Rock churches: known for their unique architecture, remote location & serenity.

Semien Mountains: Due to its unique landscape and rich biodiversity the park is inscribed on the list of world natural heritage by UNESCO in 1978.

The park is known for its wonderful topographical features on "the roof of Africa". It is an ideal place for trekking, hiking and ecological studies. Walia Ibex (capra Walie) is one of the most fascinating wild goat endemic to the park. Other endemic mammals of the country and the park include Ethiopian wolf and Heart bleeding baboons. Over 180 species of birds are recorded in the park. The flora is also as diverse as the range of habitats.

Dalol & Erta-Ale: is one of the strangest lunar landscapes studded with active volcanoes, sulphur-caked hot springs.

Rift Valley: The Ethiopian portion of Rift Valley runs from the Red sea to Lake Turkana (Rudolf) on the Kenyan boarder. In northern Ethiopia it forms the Danakil Depression an inhospitable desert dipping to an altitude of 116m below sea level, one of the lowest points on the earth's surface. The southern part of the Ethiopian Rift valley is lower, warmer and drier than other parts of the country. The Ethiopian Rift valley is dotted with chains of lakes formed during the last ice age.

Bale mountain national park: protecting the country's second highest mountain range is the best place for viewing the country's unique mammals such as Ethiopian wolf, mountain nyala, Menelik Bush buck, giant molerat and 16 endemic bird species.

South Omo: South omo is a living museum representing four of Africa's major linguistic groups including the so called the Omotic speakers. Some of the most renowned of the Omotic speakers are the Mursi known for their practice of inserting clay plates of their women. The hammer is famed for their body decorations and Bull jumping initiation ceremony.
